The Parish Council consider that this is the appropriate area to be designated as it is the area administered by Little Dunmow Parish Council.</p> <p>As the application is for the entirety of the parish council area, with no part falling outside the parish boundary, the Council is obliged to approve the proposed "neighbourhood area" for the purposes of a neighbourhood plan.
