View Corridors

Little Dunmow Parish enjoys the open countryside that surrounds the upper Chelmer valley and the Rayne Plateau. The locality has a number of historic settlements, usually on a hill which add heritage value to the vista. Community engagement has highlighted the value that the local community place on the scenic value of our surroundings. A number of views have been catalogued as being worthy of protection using the following criteria.

- A view should have a range of over half a mile.
- Views should feature open countryside or local landmarks.
- Views can be from inside the Parish as well as from outside looking in.
- Buildings shown in views should be sympathetic with their surroundings.
